



Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How do I register for the Third Annual Love Give Live 5K?

A: Sign up online at www.LifeLinkFoundation.org. Register as an individual, form a team and/or participate as a “virtual runner.” Once you successfully sign up, you will be able to personalize your fundraising page and send to your friends and family.

Q: How much is it to register for the Love Give Live 5K?

A: Sign up early to get a discounted registration rate! Registration rates are as follows

- Now through October 31st - \$20
- November 1st through December 10th - \$25
- December 11th through January 10th - \$30
- January 11th through February 9th - \$35
- Day-of-event registration - \$40

Q: Is there a children’s registration rate?

A: The registration rate for children, ages 12 and under, is \$10 less than each adult rate shown above.

Q: What is registration deadline for the 5K?

A: Online registration will end at noon on February 7, 2018. There will be a maximum capacity of 500 for race participants. Pending the number of participants before the race, individuals can still register onsite the day of event for \$40.

Q: Can I register day of event?

A: Yes, pending maximum capacity. Race-day registration begins at 6:30 AM at the registration table at Water Works Park. Please note that race-day registration is \$40. If you choose to do onsite registration, we recommend you arrive early to give yourself plenty of time for parking, time to register and then get to the start line. Also, please note that onsite registrants are not guaranteed shirts and/or medals; shirts and medals will be provided on a first-come, first-served basis.

Q: Is there a minimum age or skill level to participate?

A: The Love Give Live 5K is a family-oriented event and we encourage people of all age and skill levels to participate. Participants under the age of 18 must have a legal guardian sign a waiver on their behalf in order to participate in the walk/run.

Q: When is race packet pick-up?

A: Pre-packet pick-up will be on Friday, February 9, 2018, at LifeLink Foundation from 11 AM – 6 PM, located at 9661 Delaney Creek Boulevard, Tampa, FL 33619. Individuals can also pick up race packets day-of-event beginning at 6:30 AM at Water Works Park.

Q: Am I guaranteed a race shirt and medal?

A: All pre-registered participants are guaranteed a race shirt and medal. All other participants who register day-of-event will be given shirts and medals on a first come, first served basis.

Q: Where do I park?

A: Parking will be available along the street near Water Works Park and in the City of Tampa parking lots underneath I-275 overpass.

Q: What if it's raining?

A: The Love Give Live 5K will take place, come rain or shine. Registration fees are non-refundable.

Q: Can my pet participate?

A: Pets are prohibited from participating in this event.

Q: Are strollers allowed?

A: As the Love Give Live 5K is a family-oriented event, strollers are permitted.

Q: Where will there be water at the event?

A: There will be a water station near the mid-point of the race route. Water will also be provided at the start/finish.

Q: What are the winner categories?

A: Prizes will be awarded in the following categories: Top 3 Male, Top 3 Female, Top 3 Children (ages 12 & under), Top Fundraising Team and Top Individual Fundraiser.

Q: When will race results be available?

A: The link with race results will be emailed to participants after the race and also available on the Love Give Live 5K website.

Q: Where can I find photos from the event?

A: Event photos will be posted on the LifeLink of Florida Facebook page, www.facebook.com/lifelinkofflorida.

Q: To whom should contribution checks be made payable?

A: All checks should be made payable to LifeLink Legacy Fund. Memo: Love Give Live 5K. If the contribution should be designated to a participant or team please provide that information.

Q: Are contributions tax deductible?

A: All contributions to LifeLink Legacy Fund are tax deductible. However, per IRS codes, registration fees are not tax deductible.
